The Starlite Pack Features True Suspension

The Starlite's integrated pad pocket is designed to enhance the natural rigidity of the pack and allow for effective load transfer. Because the suspension system both transfers the weight from shoulders to hips and isolates the load from the wearer, it acts much like a the True Suspension found in packs with frames.

For loads that consistently push the limits of the comfortable carry weight. Two (optional) stays can be added to the pack. These stays will provide extra support for weight transfer, help maintain the arch of the pack and allow the **Load Lifter** straps to work more effectively.

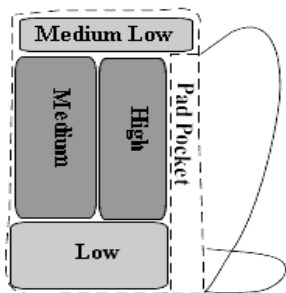
Padding Supported by The Starlite Pack

The **Starlite Pack** can use any number of sleeping pads for rigidity. **Therm-a-Rest®**, from 3/4 to full length, can be used as the primary suspension. **Z-Lite®** up to 3/4 length fit well in the Pad Pocket are another popular sleeping pad. **Closed cell** foam pads such as Blue Foam or EVA Foam may also be used. Pad thickness of 3/8th inch and 50 inches in length will work ok.

Loading Your Pack

The Starlite Pack's True Suspension System design simplifies packing. Careful loading will prevent the pack from getting "out of balance" and cause the pack to pull away from your back.

Place heavy items (food, water) high and close to your back. Store light gear (sleeping bag) low in the pack. Medium weight gear can be placed to the back or top of the pack.



Care of the Pack

The Starlite Pack is designed to give good service with minimal upkeep. Always clean your pack after usage to remove dirt. Dried dirt may be removed using a brush or damp sponge. Make sure your zippers remain clean and functional. A light coating of silicone spray will insure a longer service life. Wash the pack using mild soap and thoroughly rinse the pack in cold water to remove all residual soap. Air-dry the pack.
